Liberty Exiga

The final ingredient in Subaru's new generation Liberty line-up has arrived in the form of the versatile six-seat Liberty Exiga wagon.

Underlining Liberty Exiga's family appeal is a DVD entertainment system accessible to second and third-row passengers.

Liberty Exiga's outstanding fuel economy is aided by the stepless Lineartronic Continuously Variable Transmission (CVT), combined with the responsive four-cylinder 2.5-litre horizontally opposed boxer engine that produces 123 Kilowatts of power at 5600 rpm and 229 Newtonmetres of torque at 4000 rpm.

In the combined cycle, Liberty Exiga consumes just 8.6 litres of fuel per 100 kilometres and emits 202 grams per kilometre of carbon dioxide.

Every Subaru sold in Australia features Symmetrical All-Wheel Drive and a horizontally opposed boxer engine, standard Vehicle Dynamics Control electronic stability program, and a five-star rating for occupant safety from the independent Australian New Car Assessment Program (ANCAP).
